Safari Club International Wisconsin Chapter Inc. is proud to report that over the past 34 years it has contributed \$3,055,596 to further the goals of Safari Club International.

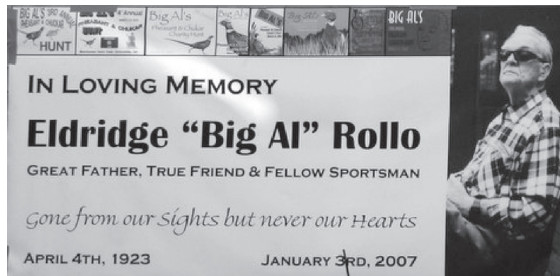
