Safari Club International Wisconsin Chapter Inc. is proud to report that over the past 41 years it has contributed \$3,199,127 to further the goals of Safari Club International.

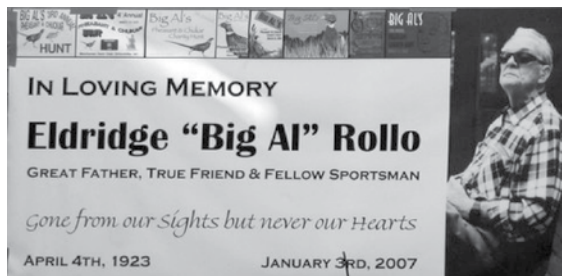
