Safari Club International Wisconsin Chapter Inc. is proud to report that over the past 43 years it has contributed \$3,406,607 to further the goals of Safari Club International.

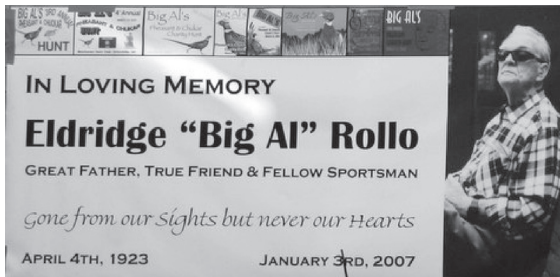
