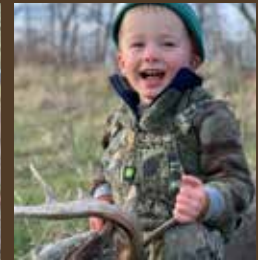

I wish I was going to be seeing all of you at our September membership meeting but I'll be on my first

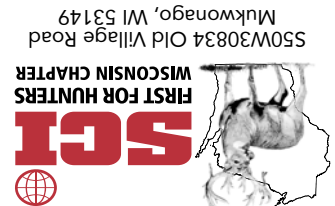
hunting trip to Africa to hunt plains game. I know many of you are also going on trips soon, so be safe, shoot straight and good luck!
